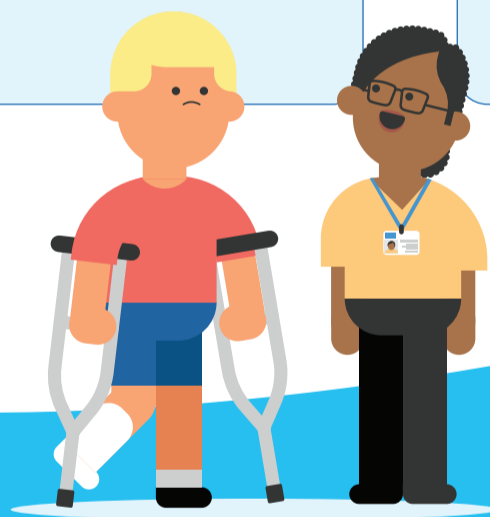
I'm not a UK resident – can I have free NHS hospital care?

If you are not a UK resident, you may have to pay for the care you get in hospital - before or after treatment.

For emergency treatment in the Accident & Emergency department (A&E) you will not need to pay.

For all hospital care that is not urgent, you may need to pay before treatment.

For hospital care you need to save your life, you do not need to pay before treatment. But you may have to pay later.



Some visitors do not have to pay charges for NHS treatment. These include European visitors with an EHIC card. Refugees and asylum seekers also do not have to pay.
