

Guide for leavers wishing to transfer training to a new NHS employer

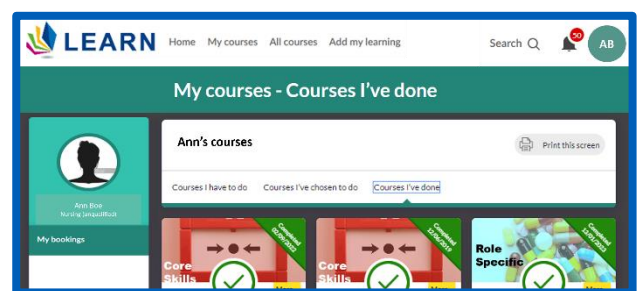
Transfer training when you move between NHS employers can save you time in having to re-do topics. If you're moving to another NHS employer, you can transfer your mandatory core skills for nationally agreed topics, saving you time from repeating them. This applies to 12 core topics.

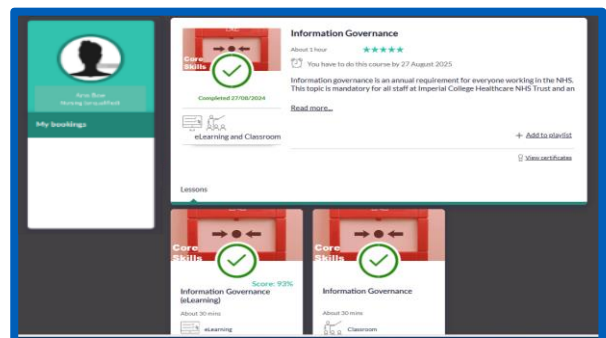

Completed courses on [LEARN](#), will be shown on your 'Courses I have done' page. You can take a screenshot of the page.

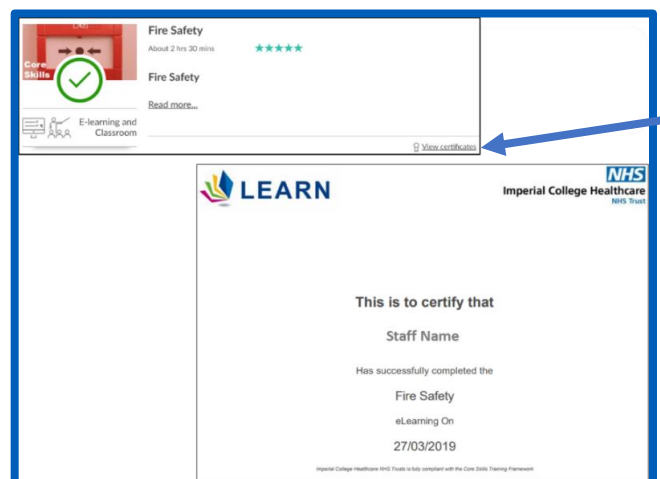
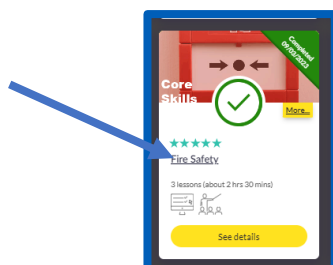


You can also open the individual course and take a screenshot of one course and the lessons which form part of that course.

You can download course certificates by clicking on the course name, and then clicking 'View certificates'.

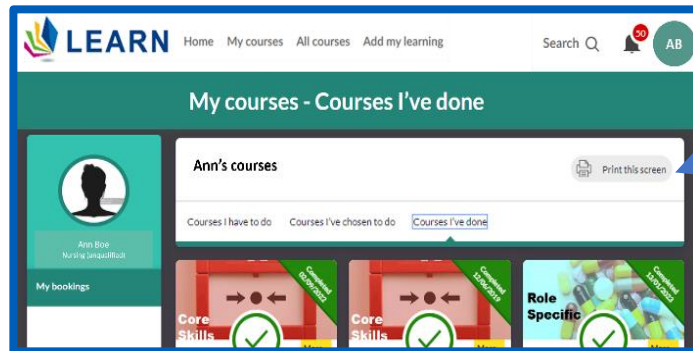


Certificates are only available once a course is on your 'Courses I've done' page. The name on your certificate is from your ICT user account.
