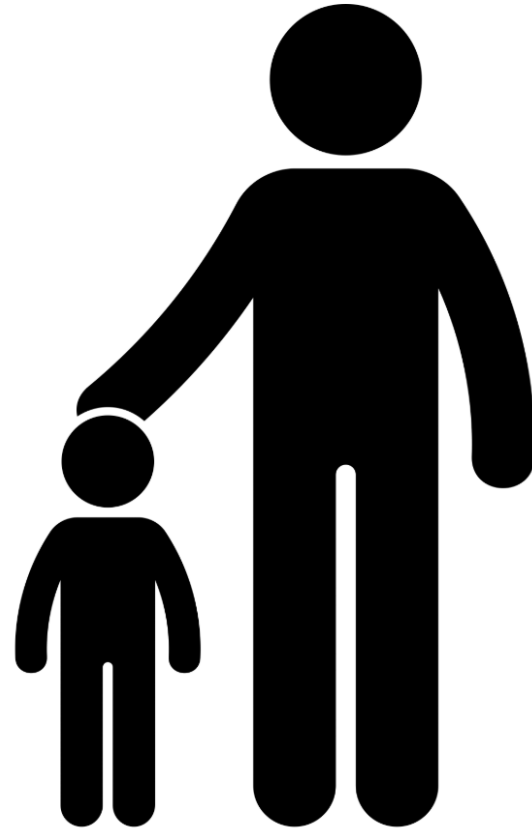
My story about getting my

checked.



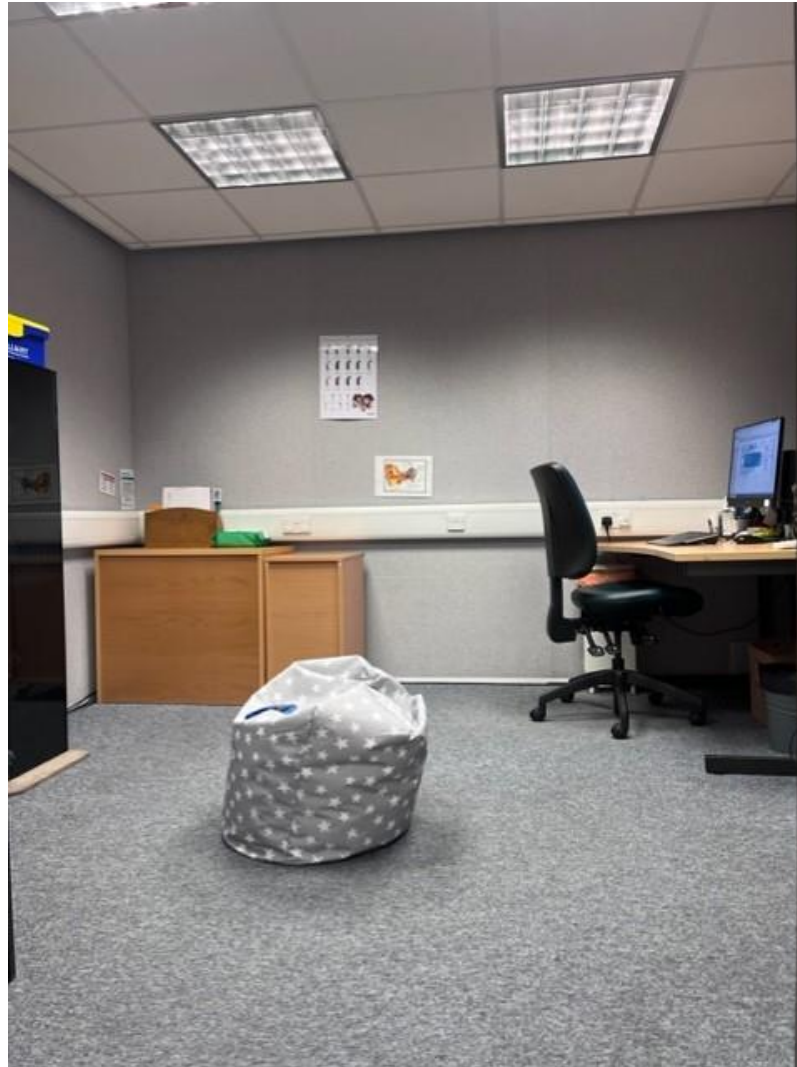
My mummy, daddy or carer take me.

The Audiologist has machines to check my hearing. I get to see them first.



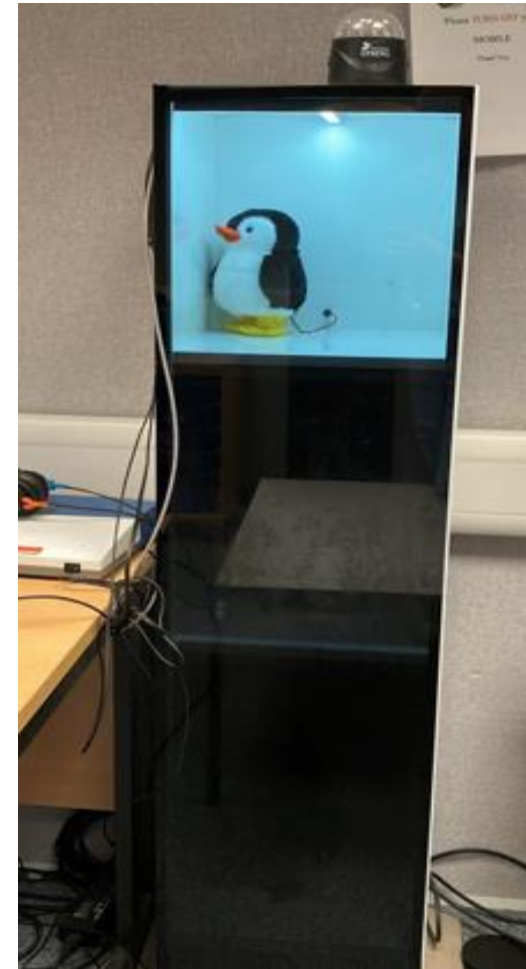
This is a special light to look in my ears.
